This form is to be used to provide notice to Local Land Services (LLS) of intended clearing under

- Part 5 Division 2 (Clearing compromised native groundcover) of the Land Management (Native Vegetation) Code 2018:

The notification form must be completed for this to be a valid notification. If you require assistance to complete or submit this form, contact your Local Land Services - Sustainable Land Management Regional Services Officer.

The landholder must retain a record of the calculation carried out for the purposes of this clause for at least 5 years after the clearing of native vegetation under this Division, and that includes:

- a map showing the area that was the subject of the calculation;
- a record of the season in which the calculation was made;
- a statement as to how the calculation was made; and
- photographs that clearly show the type of groundcover in the mapped area, taken at the time the calculation was made.

**Note:** Clearing is not authorised if the person undertaking the clearing harms an animal that is a threatened species and that person knew that the clearing was likely to harm the animal.

Land proposed to be cleared is not on Category 2- sensitive regulated land.	
Land proposed to be cleared does not contain native vegetation that was grown or preserved with public funds (other than funds for forestry purposes) where the obligations attached to the receipt of that funding are ongoing.	
The treatment are does not include any area where native species comprise more than 50% of the vegetation cover.	
Proposed clearing is only of groundcover where: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>less than 50% of the vegetation cover in the treatment area is comprised of native species of vegetation, and</li> <li>not less than 10% of the treatment area is covered with vegetation (whether dead or alive)</li> </ul>	
The percentages referred to above were calculated according to the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>the percentages were calculated by the landholder in a scientific and objective manner that is appropriate to the area proposed to be cleared and the species of vegetation that are present;</li> <li>the percentages were calculated at the time of year when the proportion of the native groundcover was likely to be at its maximum; and</li> <li>the percentage was not calculated where groundcover was significantly disturbed in the preceding six months, for example by fire, drought or heavy grazing.</li> </ol>
