Hunter Local Land Services 2017-18 Land Management Grants

Applications now open

Hunter Local Land Services is offering up to \$1.7m in grants across the Hunter Region*, which covers the Upper Hunter, Lower Hunter and Manning Great Lakes districts.

Eligible activities

- Implementation of whole farm plans and sustainable grazing, soil and land management practices, including fencing and stock water supply works, which improve groundcover, soil health and nutrient management.
- Fencing and alternate stock water supply to manage stock impacts on native and riparian vegetation, wetlands, estuaries and other sensitive areas.
- Natural regeneration and/or planting of native vegetation.
- Ongoing practices to improve the condition and connectivity of native, riparian, wetland and estuarine vegetation.
- Management of invasive weed and pest animal threats to native vegetation, biodiversity and agricultural industries.

Who should consider applying?

Commercial beef, dairy, sheep and poultry producers and other landholders and land managers in priority areas.

**The Hunter LLS Region includes the following Local Government Areas: MidCoast, Upper Hunter, Muswellbrook, Singleton, Dungog, Port Stephens, Maitland, Cessnock, Lake Macquarie and Newcastle.*

Eligibility criteria and guidelines apply.

Applications close **28 August 2017**.

Grant applications require assistance from Hunter Local Land Services staff before they can be submitted. Requests for assistance must be lodged by **1 August 2017**.
